

From Portland:

Route I (over Mt. Hood - See Blue Route map on pg. 2)

(approximately 4.5 hours, 205 miles)

- ~ take I84E/US 30E toward Portland Airport/ The Dalles
- ~ take the 238th Dr. exit (exit #16) toward Wood Village
- ~ turn right onto NE 38th
- ~ turn slightly left into NE Burnside Rd. This street will become US -26 E
- ~ turn left to stay on US-26 E
- ~ go all the way to Mitchell on US-26 E over Mount Hood through Warm Springs, Madras, Prineville

Route II (Scenic Byway along the Columbia River - Red Route map on pg. 2)

This route is part of the Oregon Scenic Byway of "Journey through Time" and takes about 40 minutes longer. There is a lot to see and do along the way.

- ~ take I-84E/US-30E toward Portland Airport /The Dalles all the way to Biggs
- ~ take I-97, pass through Wasco
- ~ go on the Or-206 ramp and turn left onto Or-206 and stay there for about 40 miles to Condon
- ~ turn right onto Or-19 and stay there for about 39 miles till Service Creek.
- ~ turn right onto Or-207. Follow the road till US- 26, about 23 miles.
- ~ turn left onto US-26 and go to Mitchell, about ¼ miles down the road.

From Mitchell

- ~ from HWY 26 go to Mitchell business loop
- ~ in front of the general store take a right up the hill
- ~ follow the sharp left hand curve towards Mitchell school (there is a small green sign for the school)
- ~ When you see the yellow house on top, take the first left turn in front of it into a gravel road (this is Rosenbaum Street)
- ~ the second house on the right is the Hollyhock Guest House (it has a sage green metal gate and a banner with a hummingbird)
- ~ the third house on the right is the Painted Hills Cottage (it has a iron gate through which you can see the garden)
